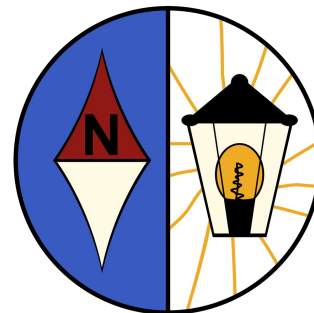
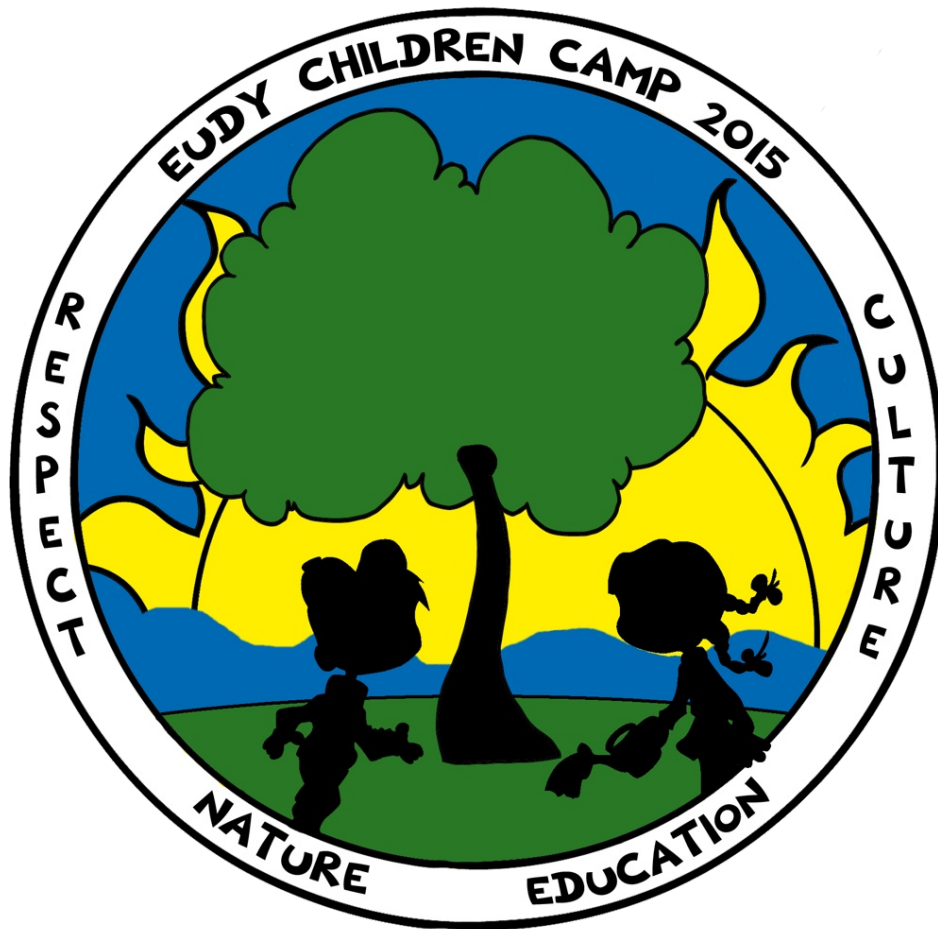


THIRD ANNOUNCEMENT

JULY 2015



This is the third and last announcement of the EUDY Children Camp 2015 for children, from 9 till 12 years old. In this news bulletin you will read the first informations about the camp which will be held in Bad Malente, Germany. This is in the north of Germany, about 80 km away from Hamburg airport.



EUDY

The European Union of the Deaf Youth is a European non-profit making organisation whose membership comprises Youth National Associations of Deaf and Youth Sections of National Associations of Deaf people in Europe. Established in 1987, EUDY is the only organisation representing the interests of Deaf Young Europeans in Europe. Currently, EUDY has 26 Full members, from Iceland to Turkey and from Spain to Finland. We are aiming to get stronger and bigger by having all member states of the Council of Europe included in EUDY and together our voice will be stronger across Europe and beyond.



DGJ (Deutsche Gehörlosen Jugend)

DGJ is a youth association of Germany (YNAD) and has many small youth associations in the whole of Germany. They support of the social, cultural and political participating of the children and young people in the form of different contributions to the self-realisation and development of the personality of young deaf people. Representation of interests of deaf young people during the public and private places at the national level. Cooperation with the other national and international associations who have also put the support and support of deaf and partially deaf youngsters to the aim to themselves. The aim of the YNAD is equal rights with all youngsters: Cohumanity with dignity, assistance to the community and culture of the deaf and a backup of the communication free of barrier in German sign language (DGS).



Nordlicht

Nordlicht is the second oldest youth association in Germany and has cofounded the German deaf youth with two other associations in 2004. They have the aim, that to guarantee the children and youngsters in region Hamburg and surroundings an extracurricular education in different forms. They concern the youngsters of from 6 to 27 years and have a good network with different associations in Hamburg. They have aimed that the educational deficits of the youngsters are covered very completely and the inclusion of all youngsters nearly realise. Cultural and pedagogic interest of the youngsters speak also directly to the youngsters at school time and after it, too.

GOC

We, the leader of German organizer committee (GOC), are very glad that we may take over the responsibility for the magnificently European Children Camp in Germany. We want to say all children and the responsible persons of all countries which want to cause with Council of Europe 'COE' welcome. 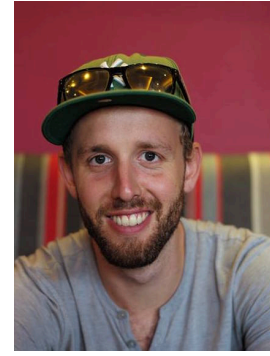

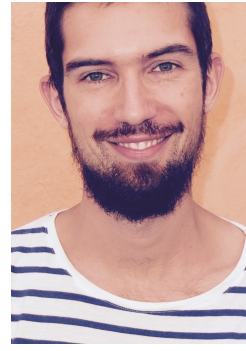

The EUDY Children Camp 2015 will be held at 9th August – 17th August 2015.



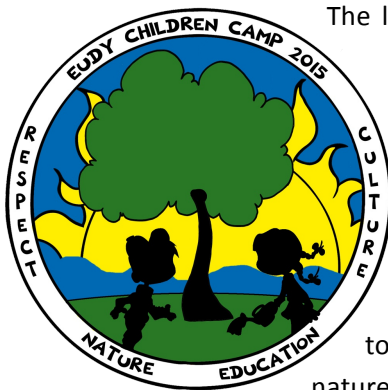
Location of the camp venue

The camp venue is placed in the north of the Germany. In Bad Malente, Schleswig-Holstein the camp will held. We have a special house from a youth hostel for us with beautiful green areas around the house. There is a lake, too. We can make activities indoor and outdoor.

Bad Malente

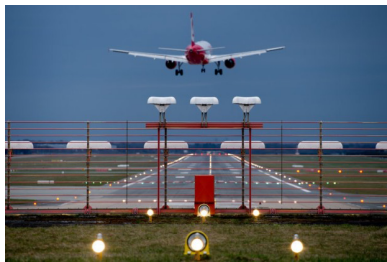

Travel information/ Caution

There are many ways getting to Germany: by air, rail, bus, ferry, and car. We will provide free transportation from **Airport** to Bad Malente and back. For the transport there are a few countries, who don't write Nils, who is **responsible for the arrival and departure time**, the deadline is at 1st June, but **we offer last deadline at 15th July**. After this you must planning your travel yourself to the youth hostel Bad Malente with train. Any different way of transport is on your own costs and responsibilities. For more information how to travel in Germany, please don't hesitate to contact us.



Airplane



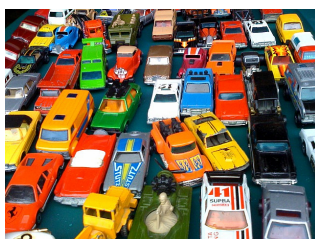
If you plan to get here by air, then please make your ticket to HAMBURG AIRPORT, Hamburg, Germany. Be sure, that you landed at 9th August 2015 between 6AM till 2PM - we are planning the last transport at 2PM and if you can come earlier, then we can plan better with the transport - if all people are landed at 2PM, then we can't plan good transport, because we drive with small bus (till 8 persons per bus). Your travel information must be stated on the schedule and send to us, as soon you know your arrival and departure times but at least one month before the camp, before 15th July, so we can arrange your transport to the camp and back. The transport at 17th August will be fix after 15th July. We share all participants in different groups, who are travel in similar time. But we planning bring the last group of participants at 1PM to airport, so all peoples who fly in afternoon or evening, must wait in airport.

Train



You shall drive with your train to `Hamburg Hbf`, there is four stations for big trains in Hamburg. There is two ways travel to Bad Malente, at first you can drive with S1 or S11 till Hamburg airport, you must sit in first three front wagons, because the S-train will share on way in two different trains, the destination is "Airport/Poppenbüttel". Be sure, that you're arrive in Airport till 2PM, so we can bring you to the youth hostel. But if you can't reach this time, then you must travel with the train to Bad Malente (you must switch one time in 'Lübeck Hbf', the destination of second train is 'Kiel Hbf' and you must take off at third station 'Bad Malente-Gremsmühlen'. If you take off, then you are in Bad Malente, you shall text the man for transport 'Nils' - he will bring you to the youth hostel. It can be happen, that you must wait longer at station, because Nils can be in busy with the transport between airport to youth hostel.

Car



If your parents or other persons are bring you directly to the youth hostel, then you shall arrive there between 2PM and 4PM, we don't confirm earlier registrations. The departure at 17th August you can fetch the participants after the breakfast at 9AM till 1PM.

Insurance/ Liability

The participants are insured for the whole duration in Germany about our insurance partner "Union" against liability insurance and accident insurance. However, this does not contain the travel expenses if the participants become ill and must take another flight. It also does not cover the transfer posting costs - they must be carried by themselves.

Notice: If you break or violate anything, you are expected to cover the damages.

Things to bring

IMPORTANT: For all participants under 18 years old **MUST** bring the “statement of agreement” with the signature from your parents or guardian that they accept our special camp rules. This form you can find under <http://eudycc2015.jimdo.com/information/form-join/>

for group photo:

- country flag for each participant and leaders (very important) - if possible in size 200x120cm

We want to make two group-photos, on first they are normal. At second picture all participants and staff reverse their back with their country flags, then all know which this person come from.

for culture night:

- things to food (we are open, that you can bring typical sweets or snacks from your country)
- or to drink (but no alcohol, it's forbidden)
- or things what is typical from your country (it can be symbol or dresses from your country)

for the camp (we don't know how the weather is, so please be in touch to inform before about the weather, it can be warm or rainy day in the august)

- general clothing
- nightwear
- underwear
- light jacket
- pants
- good and close shoes for visits or walking in the tree
- old clothes for the treasure hunt, adventure or other games
- things for bath (shampoo, soap, tooth paste, toothbrush and other things)
- rain coat or softshell jacket (useful things for wet weather)
- sunscreen, sunglasses and things what blocks sun (for example hat)
- swimming clothes (for participants, who can't swim: swim swings)
- beach towel, towels for bathroom
- money (max. 150€)

Things **don't** bring:

- camera, GoPro or any things to shoot pictures / makes films *
- alcohol / drugs
- weapons / knives

* because the total camp will focus more on this points: nature and social activities. There is a special intern for media, who will make photos and films for all participants. They get a copy from them all as DVD.

Alcohol and drug policy

Neither alcohol nor drugs are allowed during the camp days - Neither by the participants nor by the leaders. If we notice any use of such things, you will be asked to leave the camp.

Medical needs

If you have, any medical needs then please state on the registration form. In order to ensure your prescriptive medicine or syringes can be brought to Germany a prescription from your doctor must be brought along with you, to be shown to the customs prior to arrival.

Insurance

Personal travel insurance must be prepared before entering Germany. If something should happen to you during your stay, we will assist you and your leader as best as possible. If you need to change your return ticket due to illness your travel insurance should cover this.

Vaccinates

Camp Fees

The EUDY guidelines require that there is a lower price for the developing countries than for the developed ones.

For the developed countries (COUNTRY A): € 300

For the developing countries (COUNTRY B): € 200

We couldn't calculate the details of our running payments, so we can't tell how much money each participant will get back here. The treasurer Danny must calculate this after all big trips at Saturday evening and share the money at Sunday. The cashback-action belongs to the travel costs, so please bring your bill or payment-proof of your travel (flight or train) and all boarding passes (both destinations). **If you forget to bring this proof or boarding pass, then don't get cash back.**

What is included in camp-fee?

The camp fee includes accommodation, meals and activities for the whole week. As before mentioned all travel expenses are on your own.
